Partial accounting period shall be defined as a period of time less than one (1) month.

Sodexo Management Inc. shall be entitled to an annual Management Fee in an amount equal to seven cents (\$0.07) per pattern meal and meal equivalent for the 2010-2011 contract year. The management Fee shall be calculated at the end of each accounting period during the school year and prorated for any partial accounting period. Partial accounting period shall be defined as a period of time less than one (1) month.

Meal equivalents are the result of dividing the total of gross sales exclusive of pattern meal sales, and reimbursements for breakfast, lunch, after-school snack and milk program (but inclusive of cash for adult meals, a la carte food and beverages (including milk), snack bar, catering, vending, conferences, food service in-kind meals, or any other functions) by one dollar (\$1.00).

Sodexo Management Inc. guarantees that District shall receive an annual financial return of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for the 2010-2011 school year. If the annual financial return for the food service program falls short of the aforementioned amount, Sodexo shall pay the difference to the District in an amount not to exceed one hundred percent (100%) of Sodexo’s Annual Management Fee. Sodexo reserves the right to recover any such reimbursement made during the current contract year from that year’s surplus on a monthly basis.
