Room 508 – The Distance Learning Lab, is your resource for Video Conferencing, SmartBoard use, internet presentations, and many other things.

We have digital cameras available for you to borrow, video cameras, laptops, and the SmartTech Senteo Clickers. You can bring your students in to play Jeopardy, participate in group projects, share laptops, and watch webcasts on a large screen. We can accommodate groups of up to 45 students.

You can use our photo editing computer to organize, edit, and print photographs using Picasa

and Photoshop software.

I have the ability to record video from VHS to a file or onto a DVD, I can download most web-based content (YouTube is usually the source that works best for me) and put it into your folder, or load it on the Cisco IP/TV viewer so that it is available to you and your peers throughout the year. You can bring students in to be videotaped to practice presentations or poetry.

I can also provide you with (some) training on the SmartBoard, Office 2007, Imperio, or any other technology related subjects that you are interested in.

And of course, Video Conferencing. Stop by or email me and let me know of subjects you would be interested in finding programs for. I will continue to try to make suggestions, but hearing from you what you'd like to teach is the best way for me to find programs that may be relevant for your lesson plans.
