Classroom Expectations

1. **Be Respectful** - Respect yourself, your classmates, your teacher, school property, and all visitors. Treat others as you would like to be treated.
2. **Be Responsible** - come to class prepared (have all necessary materials and all classwork/homework complete), chromebooks should be charged and ready to use
3. **Be Ready** - to learn, ask questions, participate in discussion

Grading Policy

Grades will be based on the following breakdown:

- Assessments - 50%
- Assignments - 40%
- Progress Assessment - 10%

Late work

- Due dates will be announced & posted for all assignments.
- 1st day late = 25% off; 2nd day late = 50% off; assignments will NOT be accepted after 2 days late
- Assignments are due the first 5 minutes of class unless otherwise specified.

Absenteeism

- If you are absent it is your responsibility to get your missing work from google classroom, including any notes.
- Work due on the day of your absence is due the day you return (it is your responsibility to turn it in, I will not ask for it).
- You will get a one day extension per day absent for work assigned while you were out. (Ex. If you are absent one day, your work will be due one day after everyone else. If you are absent 2 days it will be due 2 days after everyone else.)
- If you are absent for an extended period of time, please reach out to me via email as soon as possible so we can make a plan for your situation.

Chromebooks

- *Your chromebook should be charged and ready to use everyday. You will NOT be able to charge your chromebook in class.*
- *Your chromebook should be handled carefully and only used for school work. Misuse of the chromebook will result in discipline referrals.*

Online Meeting Etiquette

- *When entering a video meeting, your microphone should be muted. Your video should be on (so I can see you).*
- *You should be in a quiet place (if possible).*
- *Music should be off & phones should be away.*

Late to Class

I expect you to be in class, in your seat when the bell rings. Repeated failure to do so will result in disciplinary action.

If you miss more than 20 minutes of class, it is considered an absence.

Cutting Class

- *Missing class without permission is consider cutting class (even if you are with another teacher).*
- *Cutting class will result in a discipline referral as well as a zero on any assignments that were due that day and any assignments completed in class.*

Cell Phones & Gaming systems

- *Cell phones and gaming systems are a distraction and are NOT allowed to be used in class. Repeated use will result in disciplinary referrals.*
- *Charging of devices is NOT allowed in this class.*
